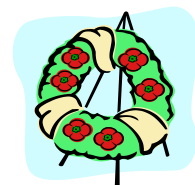
### REMEMBRANCE DAY PROGRAM

### CHRISTMAS CONCERT

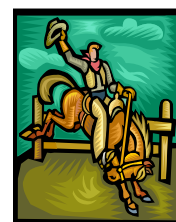
The School Christmas Concert will take place on
