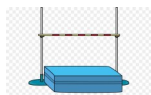


SALTCOATS SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

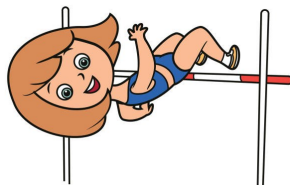

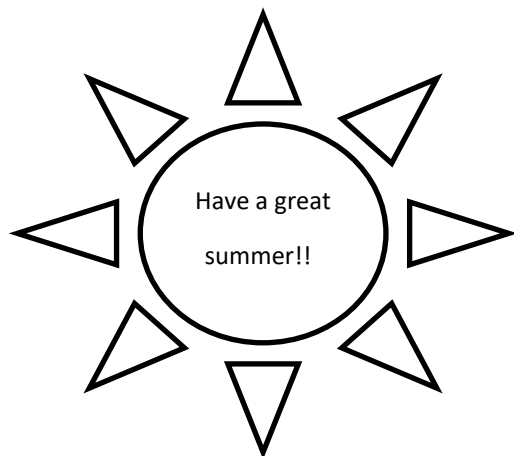
